OUR SPORTING LIFE is a series of 100
exhibitions across the UK exploring our
addiction to sport and our sporting heritage.
It will reveal hidden sporting histories,
forgotten heroes, objects and stories in
communities as part of the country's
involvement in the Cultural Olympiad and the
build up to the 2012 Olympic and Paralympic
Games.

Surrey boasts a wealth of sporting heritage.
One of the county's sporting firsts is the
earliest reference to a baseball match in
1755. The crossbar on football goals was
introduced after a match in Reigate in the
1880s and the third cricket stump was added
after a controversial match in Surrey in 1772.
Up until 1897 an annual Shrove Tuesday
street football event was a regular feature in
Dorking. Many sporting legends and forgotten
sporting heroes were born or have lived in
Surrey.

Godalming Museum has a wonderful archive
of material relating to sportsmen and women
in Godalming and surrounding villages. There
will be an exhibition and activities special to
this area of Surrey to be on show at the same
time as the touring exhibition.

Godalming Museum will be hosting this
exhibition from June 21st - July 9th.
