## **WE ARE WORKING TO PRODUCE A NEW SCHOOL BADGE TO ROLL OUT LATER NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR**

As you will be aware, over the last few years we have been working on re-branding the school. We have produced a new website, launched successful social media pages and designed a new letter head and have worked to refine the school colourway and type face. Over the course of this year, we have been consulting with our Trust and Governors on a design for a new school badge.
