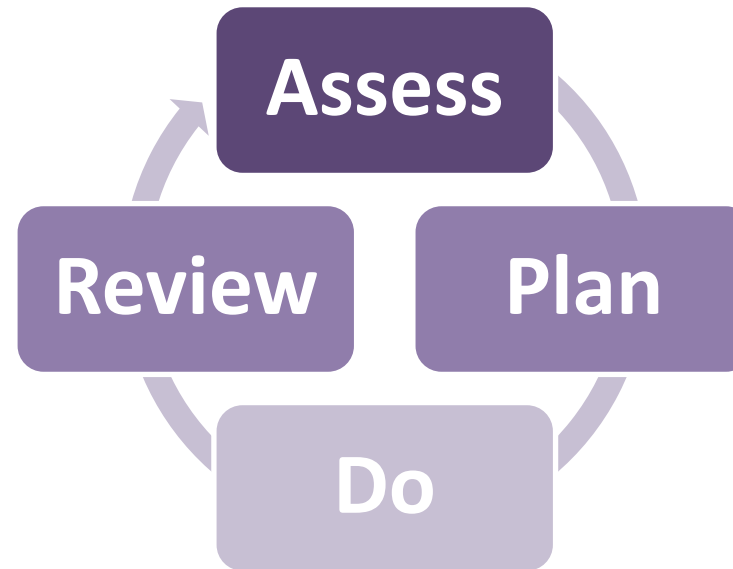


Loseley Fields Primary School Provision Map 2025-2026

All staff working with children at Loseley Fields Primary School will follow the **Graduated Response**:



Provision in school is organised into three waves of intervention:

Universal – All children have access to inclusive high-quality teaching at Loseley Fields.

Targeted – Some children will need additional programmes and/or planned support, designed to accelerate learning. This may include additional, time-limited, tailored intervention support programmes.

Specialist – Additional highly personalised interventions which may include one to one or specialist interventions.
