CONTINUING OUR FOCUS ON NEGLECT

We are continuing our focus on **Neglect** and have updated some of our resources to help with improving identification and interventions where we are concerned about a child's quality of care. These can be found on the SSCP website here.

There is still considerable progress needed to increase use of the **GCP2 tool** across all partners, and in particular and we are keen to hear from <u>all</u> teams, to help identify Practice Leads who can support and encourage others in their teams to use the tool. The responsibilities of this role are described below.

GCP2 Practice Leads

- a) Be positive advocates for the use of GCP2.
- b) Have used GCP2 at least once and be regularly using GCP2.
- c) Demonstrate good GCP2 practice and understanding.
- d) Promote the principles of the use of GCP2 within their teams.
- e) Support colleagues within their team/s to use GCP2 through general advice and mentoring.
- f) Support colleagues within their teams to use ECINS.
- g) Attend briefing sessions (1 hour every 2 months) to discuss GCP2 project, feedback key messages to and from teams and network with colleagues from across the partnership




Please share our NEW FaST Resolution Information poster.
