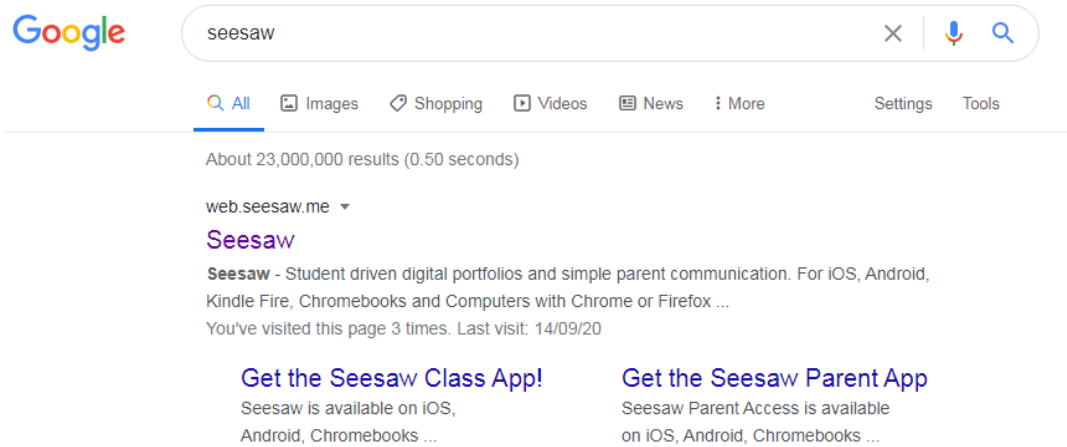

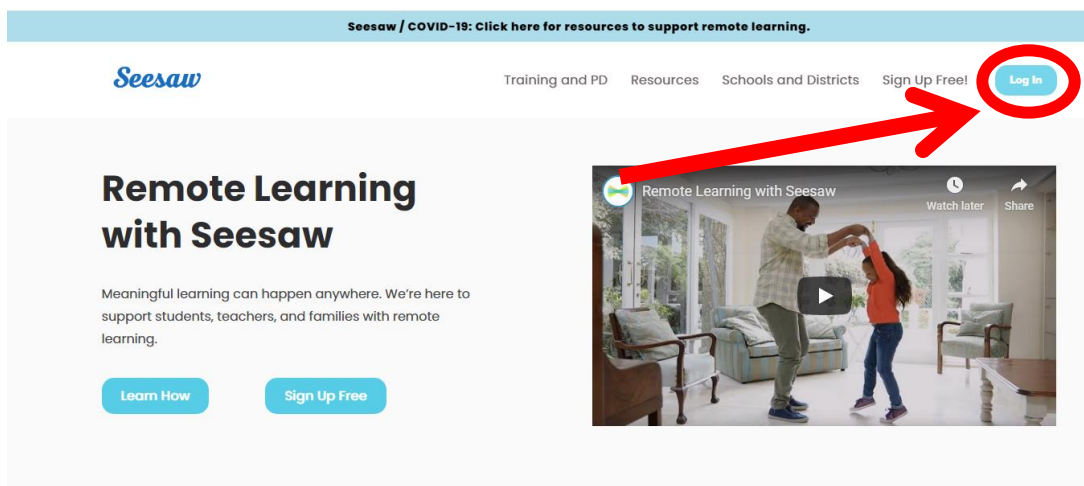

# Signing in on a computer or laptop

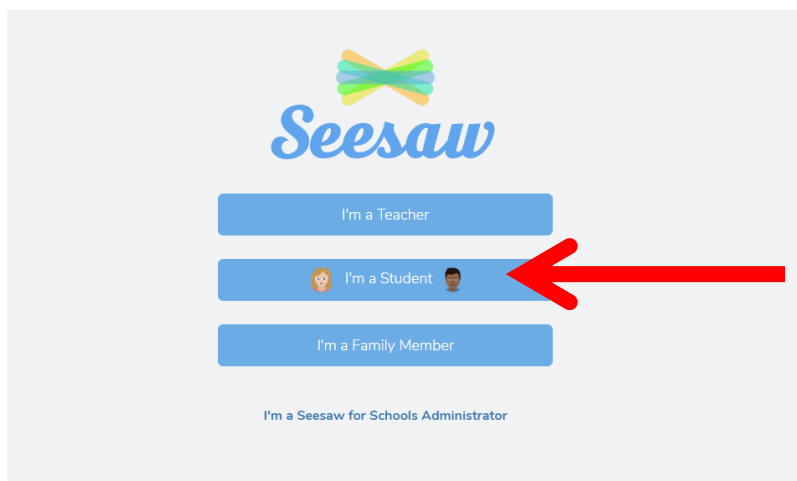
1. Type Seesaw into your search engine:

Your child can respond to the task by typing their answer in.

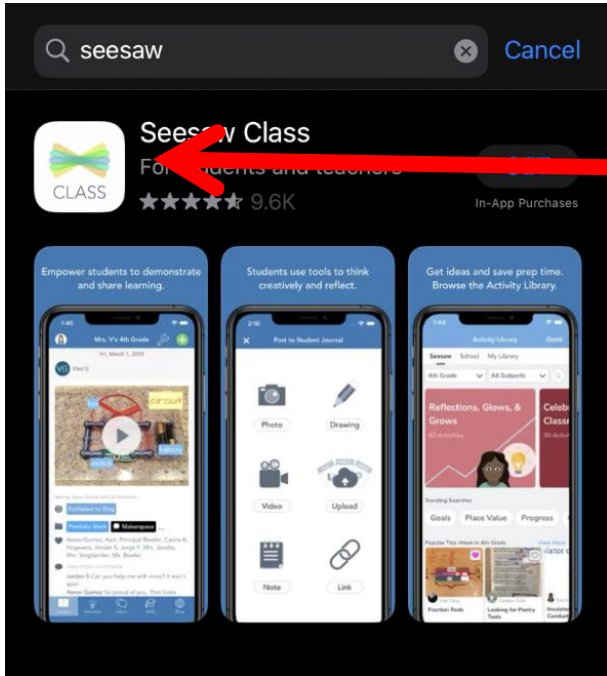
They can record their answer verbally by pressing the microphone icon.

2. Press on the 'I'm a student' tab:



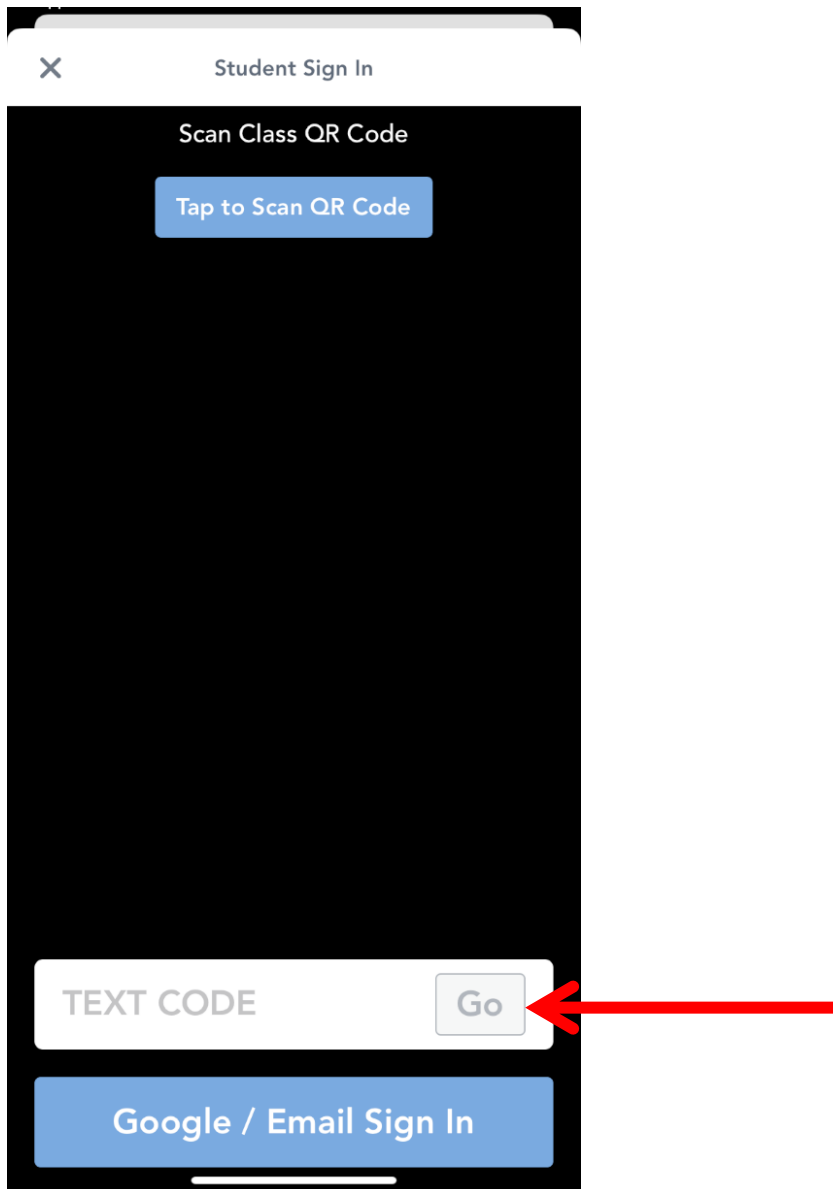

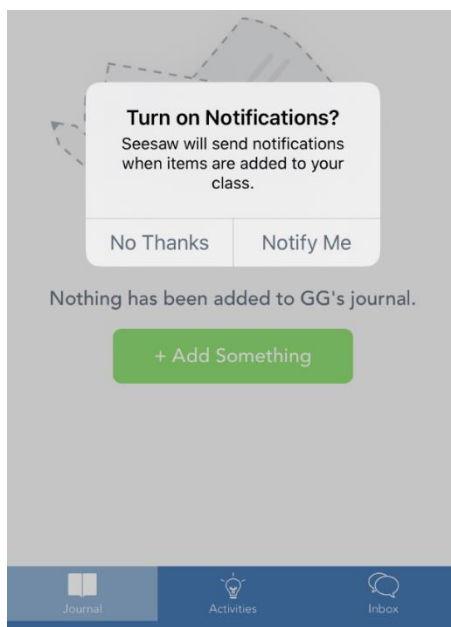

3. Type in the code you have been given by your teacher:

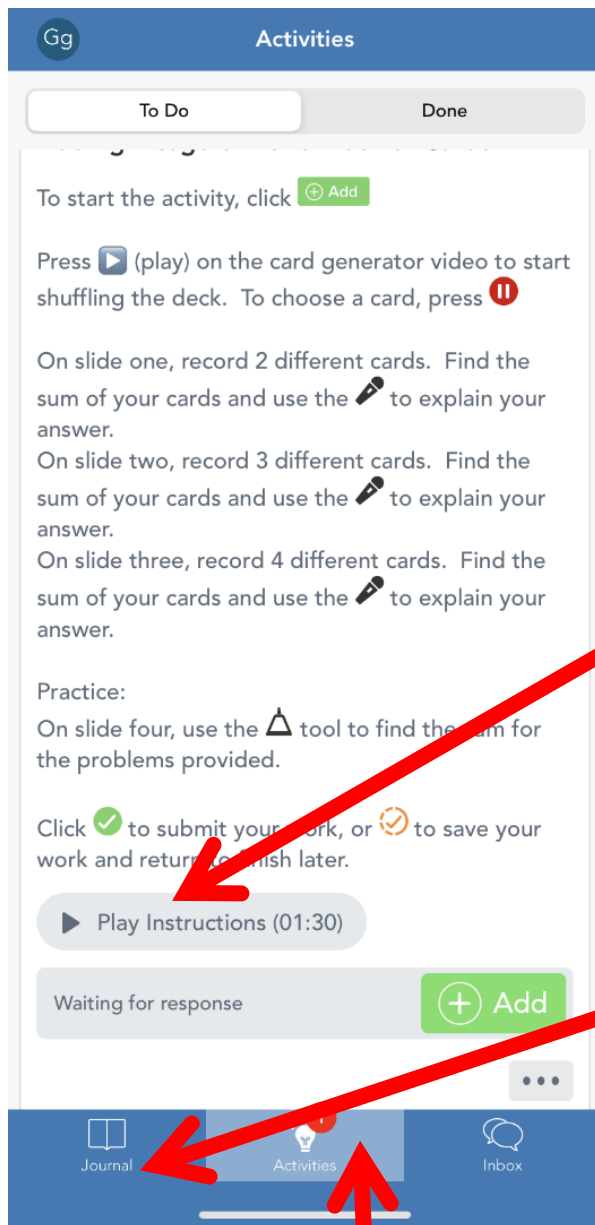


4. Decide if you would like to receive notifications or not. As a school, we would strongly advise you to receive notifications.

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The teacher will provide instructions to tell your child what they need to do. These may be written, spoken or via video.

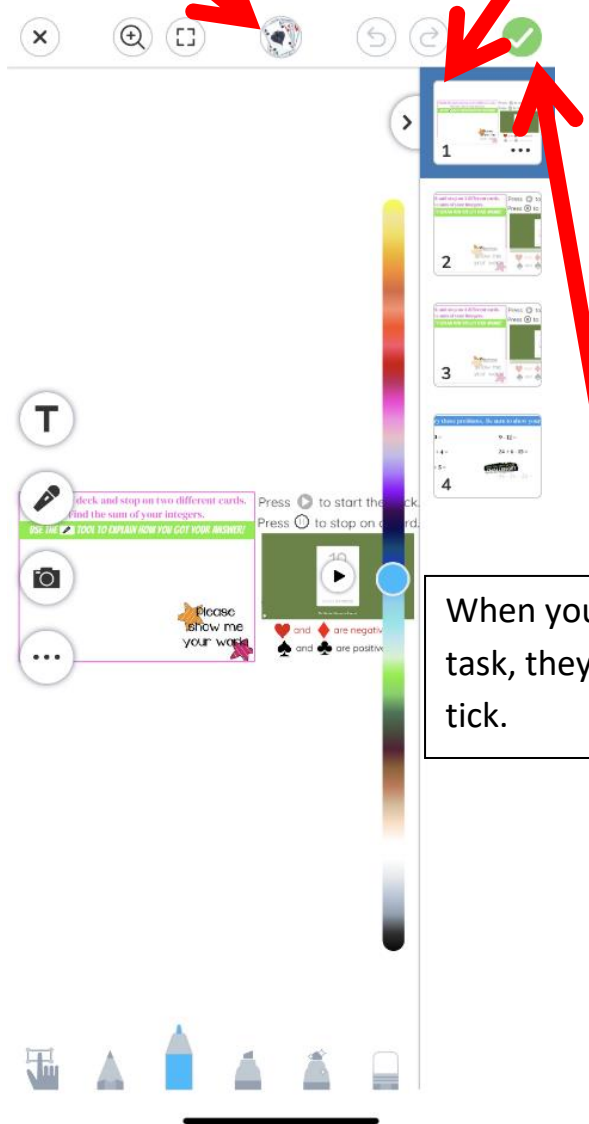

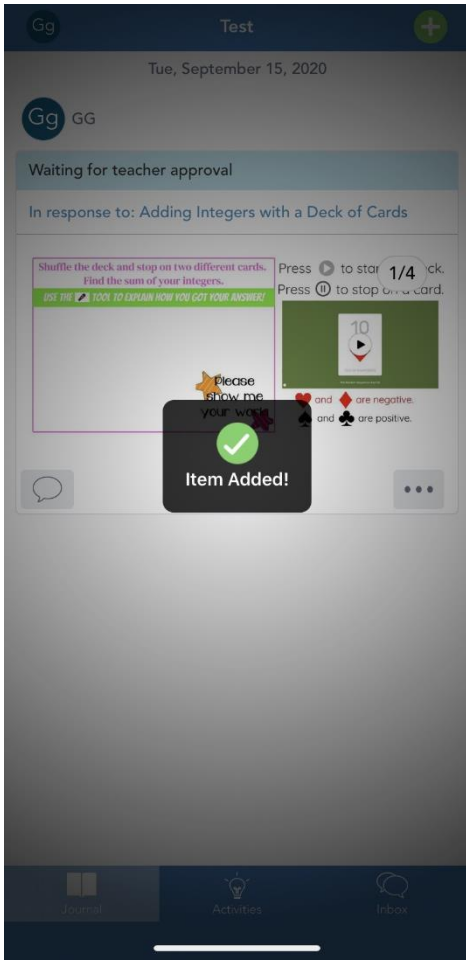


If your child forgets what they were meant to do then click on the icon at the top.
