Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to Leo Class

Once again, we have been really pleased with the way the children in Leo Class have settled into class and we are all pleased to be back in our own classrooms this year, with all the building work completed. Our older children have been doing a fantastic job helping and supporting their new, younger peers in the different aspects of life in our class and across the school. They have also all demonstrated such a positive attitude towards their learning. We would like to share some information for your reference. Please note, this includes the date for a coffee morning to come and meet us and find out more about our class.

Our curriculum

Leo Class have a four-year rolling curriculum with a new topic each half term. This is designed to enable children to revisit different learning skills and make links and connections, without repeating a specific topic during their time in our class.

This year's topics are:

- **Whose side are you on?** A history-based topic exploring and comparing the cultures of the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings, what they brought to this country and how this contributed to the establishment of our monarchy.
- **Kings, Knights and Legends!** A history and literacy-based topic, exploring the early monarchy following on from the Anglo-Saxons, and legends and tales from this time, including the legend of King Arthur and his knights.
- **Down in the Jungle!** A geography topic about tropical rainforest habitat, with a focus on the Amazon, and a conservation focus.
- **Marvellous Mayans** A history topic exploring the ancient Mayan civilisation, including the discovery of chocolate!
- **A Taste of the Mediterranean** A geography topic exploring some Mediterranean countries, focusing both on physical and human geography, and investigating food from this region.
- **Mythological Marvels – Ancient Greeks** A history and geography topic exploring ancient and modern-day Greece.

Outdoor learning:

We are lucky enough to have a fantastic outdoor learning environment at Loseley Fields which we will be using as part of our learning on a regular basis all year. Please could you provide a pair of **wellington boots** for your child to keep in school. Please also ensure that your child has a **waterproof coat with a hood in school every day**.

Home Learning

Home Learning grids – These will be available on Seesaw at the beginning of each half-term. Your child will have 6 weeks to complete the tasks of their choice. Please upload these to Seesaw once they have completed each one. We will also post links to some online maths games that the children can play.

Reading – Children will be provided with a reading book at their specific reading level. Please read a few pages every night and record these in their reading records. It is important that children are reading regularly as this will boost their reading progress. Please can you ensure that children have their books in their bags in school with them each day as they will also be reading these books with an adult in school a number of times during the week. At Loseley, children read their books at least 3 times before it is changed, as this supports their fluency. There will also be e-books and activities posted on your child's Bug Club phonics account.

Spellings – Individual spelling lists will be sent home every Monday. Please practise these spellings every day. Spellings will be checked on Friday and children will receive their next word list the following Monday.



P.E. P.E activities in Leo are spread across the week. Please note children are not allowed to wear earrings or other jewellery for P.E. Children need to be able to remove earrings themselves, or not wear them.
